This article describes the procedures and requirements of .com.br domain names.

Registration

- The Billing-Contact as well as the Owner-Contact need a local presence in Brazil. Therefore you can use our trustee service or provide us with your Brazilian register number (for the owner contact) and a Brazilian contact handle (for the billing contact).
- **Trustee service** applied automatically, if domain owner contact isn't located in Brazil.
- The registrant must be over 18 years old.

Successful domain registration via [RCP](#) or [API](#) requires:

- If domain is being registered without trustee service:
 - Valid CPF number (Social security number) for private owner contact (CPF must be given in the following format: NNN.NNN.NNN-NN)
 - Valid CNPJ number (VAT number) for company owner contact (CNPJ must be given in the following format: NN.NNN.NNN/NNNN-NN)
- Preconfigured DNS zone with at least 1 valid A-record. Zone can be verified via registry's [DNS checker](#)

NB: for registered domain names, their variations with additional ASCII characters are not possible. i.e. if **domainname.com.br** is registered, **domain-name.com.br** can't be registered. Such variations can be registered by the original domain owner only.

NOTE: A CPF/CNPJ can only be bound to one service provider (vendor) at Registro.br at a time. If it's already used to register .br domains via another provider/registrar, then registration through Openprovider fails. This is a rule from the registry, Registro.br.

In case of a Brazilian contact the two letter state value is mandatory:

Transfer

Process:

- Domain owner completes a [transfer application form](#)
 - Completed form must be **signed by domain owner** and **notarized**
- Domain owner sends the form to NIC.BR postal address stated in the document
- Once form is received by the registry, NIC.BR contacts domain owner to complete the process

Update

Owner change (trade)

There is no automated way to change the registrant of a .com.br domain.

Other update

- Requested via RCP or [API](#)
- Process can take several hours to take effect

Deletion / Restore

Delete

- A .com.br domain can only be deleted using NIC.BR [online form](#), which is only available in Portuguese.

Restore / reactivate

- **Restore** can be requested within 20 days after domain expiration
