How to register a domain?

Answer

Registering a domain from the control panel is very easy.

In order to register a domain you should follow these steps:

1. Go to **Domains Overview**> [Domain registration](#).
2. Search the domain you want. You can check if it is available to be registered or if it is not free. You can also check the price.

6. Add the name servers you want to use. If you want to use your own DNS, you must select "No nameserver group". But you can also use the Openprovider name servers if you want.

A DNS template is a pre-defined format of a DNS zone. You can define multiple DNS templates, for example when managing multiple servers. Learn more about it [in this article](#). In case of a non-existing DNS zone, create a new zone based on the following template:

	Nameserver	IP	IPv6
1.	ns1.openprovider.nl	52.57.114.204	2a05:d014:f80:6e00:bde7:af96:9434:75d5
2.	ns2.openprovider.be	52.214.115.96	2a05:d018:61d:bd00:21bc:c938:d548:dab1
3.	ns3.openprovider.eu	52.56.134.244	2a05:d01c:433:e000:e62c:faa3:9834:41e7

7. Once everything is completed, click on **To step 3: finish order**.

If the domain is correctly registered you will get a green notification informing about that. If there is any error, you will get a red notification explaining what happened.
