Registration

Successful domain registration requires:

- Registrant requirement:
 - **For private individual**
 - private individuals from Republic of Croatia having OIB (personal identification number) in the handle*
 - **For companies**
 - legal entities registered in the Republic of Croatia (trading companies, associations, political parties and other organizations with legal existence)
 - branch offices of foreign companies as well as legal entities from EU with a valid VAT number in the handle
- Two or more nameservers or a nameserver group
- .hr domains are registered manually and hence registration requests aren't processed real-time. As long as all the requirements are fulfilled, the registration normally doesn't take more than 2-3 working days.

* When register the domain for a private individual, make sure to insert the OIB numbers (without 'OIB') in the field "Passport number" in the handle of the registrant.

Transfer

Successful domain transfer requires:

- registrant requirement:
 - **For private individual**
 - private individuals from Republic of Croatia having OIB (personal identification number) in the handle*
 - **For companies**
 - legal entities registered in the Republic of Croatia (trading companies, associations, political parties and other organizations with legal existence)

- branch offices of foreign companies as well as legal entities from EU with a valid VAT number in the handle
- two or more nameservers or a nameserver group
- owner/registrant contact in the transfer request needs to match the data in the registry (whois data). An owner/registrant change would need to be done before or after the transfer.

* When register the domain for a private individual, make sure to insert the OIB numbers (without 'OIB') in the field "Passport number" in the handle of the registrant.

Important: After the request is placed, the current registrant will receive an email from the registry with a link to click on to confirm the transfer which needs to be confirmed in order to finish the transfer.

Outgoing transfer

Request transfer at the new provider/registrar. The receiving registrar contacts the registry and they send an email to the domain owner email address.

Update

Owner change (trade)

An owner change (**Trade**) is supported and can be initiated by providing support with the new owner handle. A **trade fee applies**.

Once the trade is initiated, both the current owner and the new owner will receive an email requesting confirmation. **Both parties must confirm the owner change** for the trade to be completed.

Other update

All .hr domain updates involves a fee. This is including changing nameservers, or just a telephone number in the owner data. Please refer to [Detailed domains pricing](#) for pricing information.
