

Is a Trademark Clearinghouse registration similar to a domain registration?

Question

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Answer

No, a Trademark Clearinghouse (TMCH) registration does not give you any domain registrations. However, it is a prerequisite if you want to register `yourtrademark.tld` in the Sunrise periods of a new gTLD.

If you want to register `yourtrademark.tld`, you will have to order the domain registration as you order any other domain registration in Openprovider.

Also the costs of a TMCH registration are independent of a domain registration: you pay the TMCH fee, and for each domain registration you pay the normal domain fee. In most cases, registration in the Sunrise period will be charged a different price than registration during other stages.

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
