Registration

Successful domain registration via [RCP](#) or [XML API](#) or [REST API](#) requires:

- Registrant contact require:
 - Valid full first-name. Abbreviations like "A." are not allowed.
 - Located within the EU, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland or any of the French overseas territories.
- Two or more nameservers or a nameserver group.
- Technical Contact can be a COMPANY or an INDIVIDUAL Person. If the technical contact is an individual person, his/her information will be published on the whois.

Registry maintains a list of domain names to the "reserved" status (towns, community names). If registration fails with a **"2304, Object status prohibits operation"** error (example: Object status prohibits operation: **city name (AFNIC authinfo mandatory)**), the domain can not be registered directly. Only in case the registrant has a legitimate interest (represents city council of that city or region for example) a request can be submitted to the registry to manually assess the request in order to register the domain.

If the registrant believes he has a legitimate interest / claim, please send us an email and include the handle of the registrant + his connection to the city / region + purpose of the website and we can submit the request.

Domain names under the extensions .com.re and .asso.re are discontinued since 2013. No new domain names can be registered under those extensions. Existing domains under those extensions can be managed like any other domain and can be transferred into Openprovider.

IMPORTANT:

Domain Registration Restrictions: Online Gambling and Pharmacy-Related Terms:

In accordance with French law, it is strictly prohibited to offer online casino games or online sports betting on French territory without proper authorization. Additionally, to prevent fraudulent or non-compliant domain registrations, we have enforced a keyword-based restriction within our system across all AFNIC TLDs. This change aims to ensure compliance with French regulations and to protect users from illegal or misleading online activities.

Legal Background

Gambling and Betting Prohibitions

Under Articles L320-1 and L324-1 of the French Internal Security Code and Article 56 of Law No. 2010-476 of May 12, 2010, the following applies:

- Offering online casino games on French territory is strictly prohibited.
- Offering online sports betting without an appropriate license is also strictly prohibited.

The official list of approved and licensed operators can be consulted on [Legifrance](#).

This restriction will apply to all TLDs (.fr, .re, .pm, .tf, .wf, .yt) under the AFNIC Registry.

Restricted Keywords - If a domain name includes any of the following terms, the registration will be automatically blocked:

Implementation Details

- The restriction is enforced at the time of domain registration.
- Domains containing any restricted keyword will be rejected automatically.
- Registrants wishing to use a blocked term for legitimate reasons must contact support for manual review and provide appropriate company documentation and license proof.

Transfer

Successful domain transfer via [RCP](#) or [XML API](#) or [REST API](#) requires:

- Registrant contact require:
 - Valid full first-name. Abbreviations like "A." are not allowed.
 - Located within the EU, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland or any of the French overseas territories.
- Two or more nameservers or a nameserver group.
- Technical Contact can be a COMPANY or an INDIVIDUAL Person. If the technical contact is an individual person, his/her information will be published on the whois.

The transfer period is subject to cooperation of the current registrar:

- if the current registrar approves the transfer, it completes immediately
- if the current registrar does not approve/reject the transfer, it completes after 8 days
- if the current registrar rejects the transfer within the first 8 days, it completes after 22 days

If the holder wants to cancel an initiated transfer, only the gaining registrar (Openprovider) can do so; you can cancel the transfer from the [transfer queue](#) in RCP.

The registry will not send an e-mail to the domain contacts after the transfer finishes.
