TLD in the spotlights

.nl isn't just the most popular domain in the Netherlands. It's also one of the most secure and trusted in the world.

In a [recent study](#), only 1.3% of **.nl** websites were flagged as suspect. That makes **.nl** one of the safest major extensions globally. It's outperformed only by **.au** and **.cn**.

Most **.nl** domains are actively used by real businesses, not just parked. That's thanks to [SIDN](#), its registry, which works closely with registrars and resellers to fight abuse and keep the **.nl** zone clean.

At Openprovider, you can register, renew, or transfer **.nl** domains for just **€4.25** per year. No hidden fees. No fine print.

Domains: your questions answered

Can you apply a transfer lock on .eu?

No, this is not supported for this TLD.

Can a .gr domain be restored once it has expired?

Yes, this is possible. However, this is a paid, manual operation that must be performed within 15 days of the expiration date.

How do you solve “object status prohibited action” when trying to update the IPS tag for a [.co.uk](#) domain?

To solve this, you should unlock the domain in the RCP, then change the IPS tag.

Upcoming price changes

The registries behind **.mx** and **.berlin** are increasing their prices soon, which means that prices at Openprovider are changing, too.

We want to be clear: Openprovider Members always pay the same registry prices we do for the 1,900+ TLDs we are accredited for. No markups. No hidden fees.

Besides these two price increases, we also have price decreases for **.cz** and **.hk** this month, and the **.ie** registry will soon start charging a restore fee.
