Question

Does Openprovider authorize end-users using SAML SSO?

Answer

Not yet.

SAML SSO is a Security Assertion Markup Language Single Sign-On based on XML.

Technology allows the customer to use single authorization data to be authorized into different services and domains using only one entity of credentials.

Currently, Openprovider does not have such a feature implemented but that is planned for a future. Also, there might be some useful features as a sign up / sign in using social networks account, etc.

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
