Question

I already have balance in my account, how can I register a domain name?

Answer

Using the control panel, a domain can be registered or transferred. Let's see how to do it!

Registering a domain name

To register a new domain name can be done by navigating to **Domain management > [Domain registration](#)** (You can access the new domain registration interface [here](#) or by clicking on '[Try New Domain Registration](#)' link from old domain registration interface) On the domain check page, you can enter the domain name that you desire.

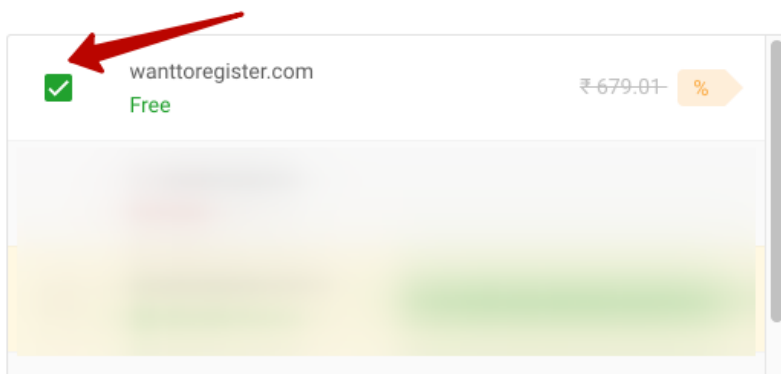


If the domain name is available, it can be registered it by clicking in the check box.

When configuring the domain name for registration you can use the customer handles that you created before. Fill in the owner, administrative contact and technical contact for the domain name and select which nameservers you want to use.

Owner Handle : This means the registrant or the domain owner, and the handle contains the information associated with that particular person/company.

Admin handle: Administrative contact. This can be same or different from the owner handle. Registries might ask for specific requirements with admin handles - depending on the TLD.

Tech Handle: It is the technical contact. This can be same as the owner handle (not necessarily). Some registries might have specific requirements for tech handles - depending on the TLD.

Billing handle: Billing contact handle for the domain.

You can use your own nameservers either by clicking on "**No nameserver group**" and writing them in the fields or selecting the nameserver group you have created under [Nameserver group management](#) (to create a new Nameserver group for your own/custom nameservers, click [here](#)). If you want to use our nameservers you can choose "**Nameservers of Openprovider**" and a zone will be created automatically (DNS records needs to be added to the zone from [DNS Management](#) or via [API](#))'.

You can choose to have the other contacts to be **Equal to domain owner**. This is very useful as you do not need to fill in each field individually with the same information. If you click on the field and start typing another contact's name it will present you with the contact handle you want to select.

Once you have filled in all the necessary fields you can order the domain name by clicking
